Protection of the Rights of Workers

Stontronics Ltd is an Equal Opportunity Employer committed to providing its employees with a safe, non-discriminatory work environment that promotes open and honest communication and embraces dignity, respect and diversity in all aspects of its business operations. Stontronics Ltd further supports the elimination of all forms of forced, bonded or compulsory labour and the freedom of association. We believe that people should work because they want or need to, not because they are forced to do so. We prohibit the use of prison labour indentured labour, bonded labour, slavery or servitude.

Protection of the Rights of Children and Young Workers
